The Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and First Friday Adoration

Mass for the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary 5:30pm followed by First Friday Adoration

Please bring any Candles you would like blessed (with your name attached) and place them in the West Transept under the Statue to Our Lady.

The feast of Candlemas, which derives its origin from the local observance of Jerusalem, marks the end of the Feasts included in the Christmas cycle of the Liturgy. It is perhaps the most ancient festival of Our Lady. It commemorates not only the obedience of the Blessed Virgin to the Mosaic Law in going to

Jerusalem forty days after the birth of her Child and making the accustomed offerings, but also the Presentation of Our Lord in the Temple, and the meeting of the Infant Jesus with the old man Simeon — the Occursus Dómini, as the Feast was anciently termed.



The King's authority: Reflection on the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Last week, Jesus announced the kingdom of God is at hand. This week, in mighty words and deeds, He exercises His dominion—asserting royal authority over the ruler of this world, Satan (see John 12:31).

Notice that today's events take place on the sabbath. The sabbath was to be an everlasting sign—both of God's covenant love for His creation (see Exodus 20:8–11; 31:12–17), and His deliverance of His covenant people, Israel, from slavery (see Deuteronomy 6:12–15).

On this sabbath, Jesus signals a new creation—that the Holy One has come to purify His people and deliver the world from evil.

"With an unclean spirit" is biblical language for a man possessed by a demon, Satan being the prince of demons (see Mark 3:22).

The demons' question: "What have you to do with us?" is often used in Old Testament scenes of combat and judgment (see Judges 11:12; 1 Kings 17:18).

And as God by His Word "rebuked" the forces of chaos in creating the world (see Psalms 104:7; Job 26:10–12), and again rebuked the Red Sea so the Israelites could make their exodus (see Psalm 106:9), Mark uses the same word to describe Jesus rebuking the demons (see Mark 4:39; Zechariah 3:2).

Jesus is the prophet foretold by Moses in today's First Reading (see Acts 3:22). Though He has authority over heaven and earth (see Daniel 7:14, 27; Revelation 12:10), He becomes one of our own kinsmen.

He comes to rebuke the forces of evil and chaos—not only in the world, but in our lives.

He wants to make us holy in body and spirit, as Paul says in today's Epistle (see Exodus 31:12).

In this liturgy, we hear His voice and "see" His works, as we sing in today's Psalm. And as Moses tells us today, we should listen to Him

Second Collection Feb 3rd and 4th for Mission Appeal

Heralds of Good News is a Clerical Missionary Society of Apostolic Life. It was founded by Rev. Fr. Jose Kaimlett on October 14, 1984, in the diocese of Eluru, India. Initially it was erected as a diocesan right but later it became an "Institute of Pontifical Right" on May 5, 1999. The specific aim of the Society is "the promotion of vocations to priesthood, the training of seminarians and the supply of zealous and hardworking missionaries to the dioceses in India and abroad which experience a shortage of priests due to the lack of local vocations." The Society has Mary Queen of Apostles and St. Joseph the Worker as the Patrons.

Mission Appeal Continued

Through the blessings of God, the Society has made rapid progress, and to better administer our members, the Society was divided into four Provinces in August 2008. In 2017, less than 10 years later, it became necessary to establish a fifth province; the Divine Mercy Province. Two priests from this Religious order are rendering their service to our diocese of Spokane. Fr. B (Baskar Anandan) is the pastor of the churches in Colton and Uniontown and Fr. Raj (Arockiaraj) is the pastor of the churches in Wilbur, Odessa and Ritzville. While this newly erected province has 130 priests and 50 seminarians in various levels of formation, they do not yet have an administrative building or even a Priests Retirement House. However, through the grace of God, they have been able to continue to run schools and hostels for the poor children in India and Tanzania. Our Moto is "To proclaim the mercy of the father." We have 130 laborers (priests) working in the vineyard of the Lord. They are rendering their selfless service in 14 countries around the world. There are 36 of them working in 12 dioceses of the USA.
